There are also a large number of LETSystems around Australia which have information and experience to share with you if you are interested in starting your own system, or in dealing with problems or difficulties which may have developed in your system. In particular, you should contemplate contacting Maleny LETSystem, in Queensland, the first in the country and still a clearing house for much information on LETS Richmond Valley LETS, in New South Wales, (sometimes referred to as RIVLETS) is also worth contacting, as they are with 650 members at 2 September 1992, arguably the biggest LETSystem in Australia. You may also find it worthwhile to contact LETSystems which are similar to your own - perhaps Brisbane if you are an urban system or a system in a rural, pastoral or mining locality in another state if your system is in a rural, pastoral or mining area of Western Australia. You may also, in contacting other systems check on the date they started, how they are organised, how many members and what is the value of current trading, and any innovations adopted or problems accounted by these other systems. If you want to find out how a 2 system InterLETS works, talk to Brisbane and Maleny, or to the South Australians, who have had an InterLETS from the beginning.

Although this list of contacts was prepared in August 1992, it was out of date almost immediately as it currently appears that there is a new LETSystem starting, somewhere in Australia, each week.

From the experience of a number of these systems, it would seem that successful LETSystems have certain features in common. Some of these are --

- Personal commitment of organisers must be strong. LETSystems that have got into trouble seem to be located in those areas where Trustees, Board of Advisers or organising committee have too many distractions to give the system the energy it deserves.
- 2. It may prove helpful to have a sponsoring organisation which understands L.E.T.S, and which is committed also to the system. Sponsors can provide assistance with accounts, can help with photocopying trading sheets, and can assist with postage. A sponsor also provides a fixed point where people can go for general LETS information or particulars on new skills or services. There is also a "down-side" to the ideas of sponsors. They may have other goals which interfere with your LETSystem.
- 3. LETSystems which thrive go out of their way to welcome new members and introduce them to long established traders. A "buddy" system or "twinning" of well established with new members may be useful in getting new members to start trading. Armadale LETSystem has instituted a monthly new members night (a Bring Your Own barbecue, rotated at different venues), with photos of the event being published in their regular LETSystem newsletter.
 - 4. A number of very successful country LETSystems have a regular (weekly/fortnightly) market or trading day. People come and exchange home-made crafts, pickles and jams, as well as other goods and services. The numbers who come varies widely, but by making it a regular event it keeps people in touch with each other.
- 5. The most successful LETSystems go out of their way to recruit local businesses. This not only bridges the rift that exists between LETSystems (which are seen as social welfare arrangements) and the fast growing commercial barter networks, and can generate federal dollars (especially, if the system charges \$100 and 100 LETS Credits for such business membership), which can be exchanged for LETS Credits through a Revolving Loan Fund to capitalise small projects.
- 6. Some Eastern States metropolitan LETSystems have Area Coordinators, who act as first point of reference to local members, seek to enrol services that are needed but not yet available to their LETSystem, and who go out of their way to welcome new members. A Community Chest, in which members are encouraged to make a regular donation, is a useful way to organise small grants to worthwhile community projects through your LETSystem.
- 7. Some LETSystems have started a bonus system (giving a bonus of a number of LETSystem credits) for members who introduce new traders to the system, particularly if those new people provide new skills or services long requested, but previously unavailable to members.

- 8. A useful innovation is to include a "brokerage fee" paid in local currency, to individuals who successfully introduce a trader to a customer. This fee rewards "brokers" and also those who trade independently without needing a go-between. In any case, the LETSystem benefits from the increase in transactions.
- 9. A LETSystem which encourages innovation, and regular meetings between Advisers and Trustees tends to thrive, maintaining morale and generating new ideas and new approaches.
- 10. Some Eastern States LETSystems also make their newsletter and trading sheet (with phone numbers deleted) available for sale through local newsagents. Not only does this provide a useful source of federal dollar income to the LETSystem, but it also keeps the system in the public eye, gives advertisers access to a wider market, and helps recruit new members to a system.
- 11. The Northern Suburbs LETSystem has a regular Christmas Party, open to all members (complete with a visiting Father Christmas!)

A LETSystem needs continual rejuvenation. This is only possible if members take the effort to continually publicise their system and make sure that meetings are fun, and that such issues as child-care and sharing food are incorporated into LETSystem events.
